This contract position is renewable on annual basis.

The successful candidate will be expected to develop various judo and jiu-jitsu programs for children all the way to adult, women self defence classes and family classes. Develop an Afterschool sport program for children age 8 to 12 years old base on the Judo Canada LTAD model. The coach/instructor will provide the necessary coaching, teaching and training to create a competitive team.
