



## Pledging Guidelines

### **Rule 1:**

Donations of \$20.00 or more are eligible for a tax receipt when indicated on the pledge form. The tax receipt request box must be checked on the pledge form otherwise no tax receipt will be issued. (Please ensure that the donor's name, address and donation amount are complete and legible).

### **Rule 2:**

**Revenue Canada says:**

Participants' personal pledges cannot be both tax deductible and eligible for pledging incentive prizes. Participants can either decline a tax receipt and use their personal pledge towards prizing **OR** participants can receive a tax receipt if they do not count their personal contributions towards incentive prizes.

E.g. if you raised the minimum of \$100, but within that \$100 you pledged yourself \$20, you must choose to receive the souvenir gift or a \$20 tax receipt, but not both. However, if you raised \$120, and within that you pledged yourself \$20, you can receive both the prize and a tax receipt.

### **Rule 3:**

Pledge money must be received no later than Sunday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm in order to be eligible for pledging prizes.
